- Given the threatened Southern Forests, in particular the Lower Weld Valley, an international profile.
- Lobbied the World Heritage Committee concerning threats to the Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area from logging along its border, resulting in a strong resolution and a planned delegation.
- Regularly hosted important community events such as the Cygnet Herb, Health & Organic Expo, and the southern Forest Festivals.
- Provided a community space for movie nights, information sessions, home schooling classes, workshops and social occasions.
- Gained continued support from organisations like Australian Ethical Investment & Superannuation, and the Rainforest Information Centre.
- Created an artists' collective that has held many successful exhibitions in Tasmania and the rest of Australia, including the annual 'Weld Echo', and released a double cd of Australian & international musicians supporting Tasmania's forests.
